Year-One Milestones

(June 2007 –December 2008)

By December 2008, the Partnership for Prince George's County will have:

- I. Collected data to assess:
 1. What other entities have or are gathering data about Prince George's County nonprofits (e.g., efforts by Kaiser Permanente health data collection, Maryland Association of Nonprofit Organizations' nonprofit assessment, etc.);
 2. Current funding commitments in the County including funding gaps;
 3. The capacity of and ways to support the efforts of the Prince George's County Human Services Coalition (HSC) to serve as an effective partner in the Partnership, including engaging and broadening HSC's constituency of nonprofits; and
 4. The organizational capacity needs of nonprofits in the County and the Partnership's strategic response.
- II. A shared definition of leadership, advocacy and capacity building strategies as established by Partnership members;
- III. Created a collaborative funding pool designed to help increase Foundation support in the County;
- IV. Announced the Partnership Grants Program;
- V. Documented grantmaking process including evaluation;
- VI. First round of grants awards announced;
- VII. Broadened the number and types of leaders (e.g., public officials, business leaders, etc.) engaged in supporting nonprofit capacity building, leadership, and advocacy in the County;
- VIII. Developed a website, including a group listserv that allows Partnership members to post and share data, resources, funding opportunities, etc.; and
- IX. Partnership participated in the at Council on Foundations Annual Meeting at National Harbor, May 4-8, 2008 (possible venues include: presenting the Partnership at a session or hosting a site visit.
